This petition is submitted under the provisions of S.C. Code '5-3-150, authorizing the City Council to annex a defined area when presented with a petition signed by at least seventy-five (75%) percent of the area's freeholders who own at least seventy-five (75%) percent of the area's assessed value of real property. This petition and all signatures thereto shall be open for public inspection on demand at the City Hall, located at the address set forth above. If the original of the petition is still in circulation for signatures, or otherwise not available, at the time demand is made, then the original shall be made available as soon thereafter as reasonably practical and in the interim a copy shall be made available. Any person who seeks to challenge the annexation, and who has standing to do so, should act in accord with the requirements of Chapter 3 of Title 5 of the South Carolina Code.	which is contiguous to the City of Greenville and which is proposed to be annexed into the City.
